Anatomy of the UL Toy Safety Certification Mark

UL Consumer and Retail Services offers the UL Toy Safety Certification Mark to the toy industry. The Mark brings heightened credibility to a product's safety, communicating the toy meets UL's stringent compliance requirements.

UL Toy Safety Certification Mark Program

The three-phase UL Toy Safety Certification Mark Program includes supply chain risk management in addition to product testing to promote continued compliance throughout production.

PHASE 1 - PRODUCT TESTING

The UL Toy Safety Certification Mark Program requires testing in accordance with ASTM F963 Standard Consumer Safety Specifications for Toy Safety.

Some basic tests included in the program are:

- Mechanical use and abuse
- Flammability
- Chemical testing for lead and other heavy metals

PHASE 2 - SUPPLY CHAIN AUDITS & INSPECTIONS

• **Quality Systems Audits** - UL audits each facility in the supply chain once a year to verify quality systems at each site level

• **Production Quality Inspection** - includes periodic product inspection as well as assessment of the factory's quality control checkpoints and sample collection. UL will test toys multiple times during production to determine quality and continued compliance

• **Follow-Up Services (FUS) Inspections** - UL inspects manufacturing site that utilizes the UL Toy Safety Certification Mark four times a year to confirm compliance with the program's requirements

PHASE 3 - PROGRAM MANAGEMENT

Once certified, you can create and download Smart and Enhanced Marks and Badges from a dedicated marketing site, UL Marks Hub.

Users can begin to design packaging and print Smart and Enhanced Marks and Badges for their products once service terms have been signed, a project quotation is accepted, and the user registers on the UL Marks Hub.
