As of Wednesday, March 25, 2020, in response to the Government of India's (GoI) announcement of a nationwide lockdown for 21 days, UL Leadership decided to immediately suspend the operations of laboratory services in Gurugram and Bengaluru. We expect to reopen our laboratories with complete services on Wednesday, April 15, 2020. This reopening date may change based on the direction of local authorities and/or UL Leadership.
